- 7. Involve workers in health and safety activities especially the health and safety committee.

- 8. Encourage everyone to contribute to the continual improvements of the health and safety.
- 9. Make relevant Health and Safety information and training available to workers.
- 10. Encourage and support the early return to work of injured workers.
- 11. All workplace incidents and accidents will be promptly reported and accurately recorded.
